



Donation and Social Responsibility Policy

Purpose:

To ensure that SlavkaSk meaningfully contributes to social and environmental well-being through structured, transparent, and impact-driven initiatives. By supporting disadvantaged communities, educational efforts, and green innovations, the policy reflects the organization's commitment to sustainability and ethical responsibility.

1. Principle

As a nonprofit international organization, SlavkaSk commits to allocating at least 10% of its corporate earnings to donations serving social and environmental purposes. These donations are not campaign-based but are conducted in a systematic, transparent, and auditable manner.

2. Priority Areas of Support

Primary target groups and thematic areas for donations include:

- Supporting disadvantaged communities, especially those living in areas affected by plastic pollution (e.g., coastal regions, communities near landfills).
- Supporting education and training, with special focus on:
 - sustainability and waste reduction,
 - awareness of pyrolysis technology,
 - environmental education for young people.
- Organizing and funding participation in scientific and technological conferences and international forums.
- Local awareness programs and events aimed at:
 - presenting the impacts of plastic pollution,
 - engaging local communities,
 - improving the social acceptance of SlavkaSk's activities.
- Providing special support for the protection of women and children in regions where waste-related issues pose health risks.
- Supporting green innovations and startups aligned with SlavkaSk's mission.

3. Community Grant Fund

SlavkaSk n.o. publishes an annual call for proposals, through which communities, schools, associations, or civil organizations may request support for:

- educational programs
- infrastructure development (e.g., water purification systems, waste collection points)
- event organization

Applications are evaluated by a professional board of trustees, and results are made public.

4. Transparency and Monitoring

An annual Social Responsibility Report is prepared detailing donation amounts and recipients, and is published on the website. Supported programs must submit progress reports, which are archived by SlavkaSk's central office. In cases of misuse, support will be immediately suspended and legal action initiated.

5. Social Recognition

Each year, SlavkaSk awards the most impactful programs in terms of social contribution. Awardees are featured at SlavkaSk's international forums, events, and online platforms.

6. Additional Recommended Forms of Support

- Launching volunteer programs for SlavkaSk employees (e.g., school presentations, community clean-ups).
- Social mentorship programs: involving youth in the development of sustainability innovations.
- Supporting film and documentary projects showcasing plastic pollution around the world and SlavkaSk's solutions.
